Membership: The UCLA Emeriti Association suffered a drop in membership during the pandemic. The drop appeared to be due to the fact that in-person events could not be held and that we relied only on solicitation by email rather than postal mail. Happily, after we resumed in-person events and restarted use of postal mail our most recent count indicates that membership has now recovered to pre-pandemic levels.
